



Friday 11 September – ESSE

Kay and John Ward will kick off our new year with a walk beside the river Issoire. We will meet at the Stade at **Esse**, which is on the left hand side of the D80 from Confolens to Brillac. From here we will decant into cars as there is limited parking space where the walk begins.

The walk will be along the river walk, which will be muddy in places, with one steep climb and one set of stepping stones in the river, but otherwise flat. It will be about 4 kms long.

Friday 9 October- CIVRAY

Dave and Marilyn Trigger will lead us on a circular walk through St Pierre d'Exideuil. We will meet in the large carpark by the river at Civray. As you enter Civray from the Savigné direction, having passed the police station on your left, you will come to a new roundabout. Turn left at this roundabout and then first right and the carpark is immediately on your left.

The route involves a riverside stroll and country lanes with a bit of road walking to see the countryside around that area. There are some uphill climbs included. The walk is about 5kms long.

Friday 13 November- LA VAUZELLE, NEAR BRILLAC 16500

After approximately 2 Km turn left (signposted La Vauzelle, La Gaite and Transvaal). La Vauzelle is the first hamlet you enter, turn right and that will lead to the meeting point. Facilities are available.

The walk is over undulating, stony, Chemins with a short section of tarmac used by local traffic. The steepest section is also the shortest and is at the end of the route.
