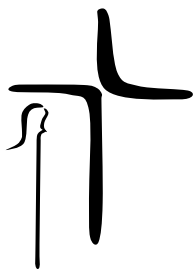

Qualifications to be elected as a representative of the laity as follows:

- (1) Your name must be entered on the Electoral Roll.
- (2) You must be an actual communicant as defined by rule 54(1). "Actual communicant" means a person who has received communion according to the use of the Church of England or a Church in Communion with the Church of England as least three times during the twelve months preceding the date of his/her election or appointment being a person whose name is on the roll of a parish and is either(a) confirmed or ready or desirous of being confirmed – or (b) receiving the Holy Communion in accordance with the provisions of the ecumenical canons (B15A, paragraph 1(b)).
- (3) You must be 18 years or upwards.



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
